## **Waves by Jon Divens & Fernando Viso**

<u>Waves</u> is a Family Movie following **Magdalena** (**Lena**), a Galapagos Penguin, on her journey to compete and excel in the male dominated sport and tradition of body surfing.

The hero picked up her love from surfing as a baby from her **Aunt Gracie**, before she was swept out by the strong undercurrent, never to be seen again. This tragedy unfortunately convinced her father **Franco** to forbid his daughter from ever entering the ocean, forcing her to hone her surfing in secret as she grew up. The encouragement of **Sunny**, a carefree Sea Turtle contestant, and her inability to take her mundane life anymore pushes Lena to do the unthinkable. Compete in the Galapagos Open.

The Wisemen (Thomas, Java, & Paco) have been tasked with keeping the traditions of the Open alive, just like their predecessors for hundreds of years before them. Lena knows these are the men she needs to impress, and sneaks into the reserved training facility, dominating the waves for all to see. Thomas is irate a girl has desecrated the scared training grounds, but her talent is undeniable. Even the cocky current and former champs, Don Juana Del Iguana (Marine Iguana) & King Kobe (Seal), know they are going to get a run for their money.
